MINUTES

1. The meeting was called to order at 8:09 am by Dave Kalinowski.

2. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION: Jeff Barbe stated that Larry & Liliane Hill of Skydive Arizona are willing to provide an aircraft and skydiving performances for this year's Aviation Expo.

3. MANAGER AND STAFF REPORTS:

Airport Supervisor Sean Kienle reported the following Recent Fuel Sales:

The RWY 3 PAPI's were flight checked by FAA on Tuesday, January 14th and should be commissioned soon in order to mitigate an obstruction that protrudes into the RWY 3 glide path.

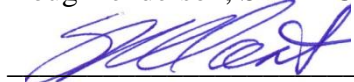
