MINUTES

1. The meeting was called to order at 8:03 am by Kimberly Jackson.

2. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION: None

3. MANAGER AND STAFF REPORTS:

Airport Supervisor Sean Kienle reported the following Recent Fuel Sales:

- a. March 2014: \$15,460.60 (3,198.27 gallons ↑ 16% over March 2013)

Sean also reported that the new Airport Identifier (KJTC) has been activated but not published. The LOID has been approved for publishing by the FAA and should be published in the next update on May 29th. The wildfire season has begun with 2 deployments of the Heli-tack crew already. The south hangar gate was discussed with Sean noting that he has ordered a new solar panel. Larry Hill offered to buy direct-burial wire to supply power from his hangar to a charging system if needed as long as the Town provides the trench.

Sean gave a status of the planning for the June 7th Fly-In. AZ National Guard denied the request for static display aircraft due to the ongoing sequester.
