MINUTES

1. The meeting was called to order at 8:07 am by Chairman Doug Henderson.

2. PUBLIC PARTICIPATION: None

3. MANAGER AND STAFF REPORTS:

Airport Supervisor Sean Kienle reported the following Recent Fuel Sales:

- a. April 2014: \$21,584.52 (4,604.42 gallons ↓ 37% from April 2013)

Sean stated that the Angel Thunder exercise of May 09, 2014 brought \$3,023.48 (677 gallons) of fuel sales during the 7 hour duration of the exercise. There were 2 Blackhawk helicopters and 2 C-12 King Airs.

Sean reported that he attended the annual Arizona Airports Association's Spring Conference in Yuma in April and will attend annually. He noted that one topic of particular importance to the FAA was the inspection of all hangars, private or otherwise. He presented a letter directed to the legal counsel of the Glendale Airport in which the FAA specifies the conditions which all federally obligated airports must meet. Sean will prepare a letter to the hangar owners and tenants notifying them of the upcoming inspections and the conditions they must comply with.

Sean reported that he has submitted a request with Kirtland Air Force Base in Albuquerque for a C-130 fly-by during the Aviation Expo.
